## WELCOME TO THE 2018 CHORAL FESTIVAL AT BROOKHAVEN!

We are excited to share our plans with you for the 24<sup>th</sup> annual Choral Festival at Brookhaven!

Once again, we are holding our rehearsals at the United Methodist Church 482 Middle Road in Bayport. You should park on Middle Road for the first rehearsal, then walk around to the Snedecor entrance and check in at the parlor behind the sanctuary. Lighting in both the sanctuary and the community room is fairly good, but if you need a boost, bring a book light. Water is permitted in the sanctuary, and you might want to bring a sweater, just in case. Music must be ordered in advance, through JW Pepper. Please bring it all to the first rehearsal.

We are delighted to welcome Martha Campanile, Eric Blatt and Alan Rubinstein back to the podium. Our program this year, in part, celebrates Leonard Bernstein's centennial. We mark this auspicious occasion by featuring selections from two of his most famous works, *West Side Story*, and his *Mass*. We also have some choral classics on the program – the Rutter *Te Deum*, Mozart's *Regina Coeli* and a family favorite, selections from *Mary Poppins*.

Unfortunately, we won't be performing at Gateway this summer – our schedules didn't mesh, and we will miss being there. But we will be able to let you know in the next few weeks where our performance will be. In the meantime, be sure to reserve your space!
